The hall needs to have a constant temperature of min. 20° C. During the performance the heating system works in silence.

3. ORCHESTRA PIT

We don't use the orchestra pit.

4. OVERHEAD PIPES

Pipe height: 7-10m. We prefer not but we can do a version with a pipe height of 5.5m.

5. MASKING

All the masking and rigging is provided by the organizer.

The house should be completely dark.

6. ELECTRICITY

Separate clean power circuits for light, sound and video and UPS for each at the control are provided by the organizer.

7. CONTROL

Audio, light, video and surtitles are placed together, preferably at the middle of the auditorium because of the surround, dimensions 4mx2m.

Light, video and surtitles can be positioned at the back of the auditorium but with a clear view upon the stage. Dimmensions for each: 2mx2m.

The organizer provides 5 comfortable chairs.




